



Dear Boarder,

We'd like to start off by introducing ourselves, we are the Lettleiki Icelandics Team. We have combined decades of various equine experience between all our staff members. To learn more about us, check out our bios on the barn website or feel free to ask us questions. We look forward to working with you and your horses!

As a reminder, here's a summary of our regular and optional services at Léttleiki.

Vaccinations (Standard)

February	Strangles/Strep Intranasal
March	Flu/Rhino, E&W Encephalitis, Tetanus, West Nile (6Way) Coggins Rabies Fecals
June	Rhino
September	Flu/Rhino Botulism
December	Rhino

Vaccinations are administered by Dr. Jack Watt of Kentucky Equine Hospital. We recommend that long-term boarded horses are transitioned to our vaccination schedule. If your horse is not and you'd like them to be, please provide your mailing address and email to us and Dr. Watt will bill you directly. We request that any horses not using our veterinarian's services provide proof of current vaccinations for our records.

Parasite Management (Standard)

Our protocol for fecal exams and deworming is advised by Dr. Martin Nielson of the Gluck Equine Research Center at University of Kentucky. In March, **all** horses on the property are fecal tested and you will be billed by Dr. Watt or Lettleiki. You will be notified if your horse's results come back positive, followed by treatment then retesting to ensure it was effective. In the fall, all

horses will be dewormed with a combination dewormer Ivermectin/Praziquantel. Horses 3 or under will be added to our “Young Horse Deworming Protocol.”

When applicable, we will bill you for any deworming costs.

Coggins/Health Certificates (Optional)

In March, Dr. Watt prepares Coggins and Health Certificates for our horses who may be traveling. Please let us know if you would like to use his services for your horse, and he will bill you.

Dental Services (Optional)

Dr. Jack Easley provides dental services in Spring and Fall. You can choose to schedule at the same time as our horses and are welcome to be present to make further decisions as needed when your horse is being checked.

Dr. Easley also offers sheath cleaning for geldings and stallions while your horse is sedated for dentistry. Please let us know if you'd like your horse to be checked, floated, or otherwise treated. You will be billed directly by Dr. Easley for these services.

Body Work (Optional)

Dr. Fike provides chiropractic and acupuncture services for horses at Léttleiki on a routine basis, and Theresa Swanstrom is available for MagnaWave appointments as needed as well. Ask us when there will be a scheduled appointment and we will help you arrange services for your horse.

We charge a small fee for handling horses for veterinary or other equine professional examinations, and giving medications. .
