WHAT DOES WORLD RANKING MEAN?

The FEIF World Ranking is a system to compare results between riders of pure-bred Icelandic horses at selected sport event all over the world. The position of a rider in any class in the FEIF World Ranking is based upon the arithmetic mean of their three best results with a horse in a world ranking class. Any rider will need at least three scores (that is why we are running three separate one day competitions) of 5.5 or higher in the preliminary round of the classes T1, T2, V2, F1, T3, T4, V2, and F2 or the equivalent time in Speed Pass P2 of 8.70" in order to qualify for the World Ranking. A WR competition must have five judges and three must be International Sport Judges. The highest and lowest marks of the judges are disregarded and the final mark is based on the average of the remaining three scores. Results are valid for a period of two years.

WHAT CLASSES ARE YOU GOING TO RIDE AT THE TRIPLE WORLD RANKING SHOWS?

First remember that we are actually running three separate World Ranking competitions during one weekend, one each day Friday, Saturday and Sunday and there will be no finals. This is a great opportunity to try out and practice classes and get feedback from judges at ANY RIDING LEVEL from beginning riders to world ranking competitors.

AWARDS

The final day of preliminaries, after each World Ranking class has been completed, the top scoring five horse/rider combinations in each class will receive Ice Championship awards based on their combined two highest scores from the three competitions.

For the other classes medals will be given daily in each class. On Sunday after the final running of each class an additional Ice Championship award will be given to the horse/rider combination with the two highest combined scores over the three days of competition.
