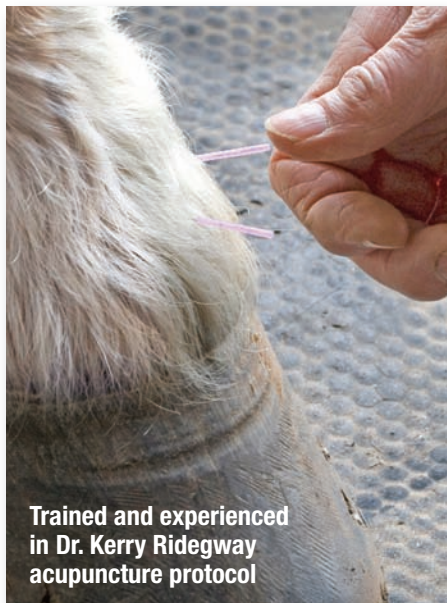
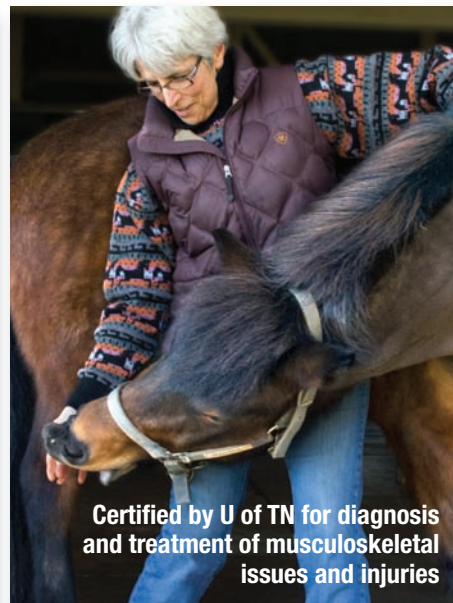

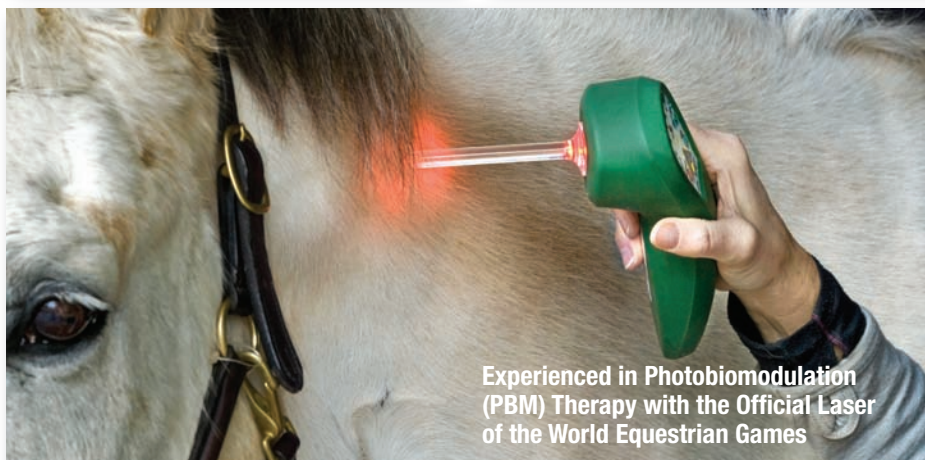

Saturday 6/3: Post-work appointments available after judging to aid recovery.

POSTURE MOVEMENT SESSION: Show Special \$180

Examination:

- Complete body inspection, palpation and postural analysis.
- Dynamic gait analysis – limb strength, timing, proprioception
- Evaluation of flexibility, joint range of motion, spinal motion, fascial restrictions/trigger points

Therapies to be integrated for best results:

- Acupuncture, soft tissue mobilization, joint mobilization, myofascial release, active/passive stretching, written therapeutic exercise recommendations and handouts.
